The impact of edentulism on oral and general health is proven throughout dental and medical literature. Tooth loss is a debilitating, life altering, and irreversible disease that can lead to impairment, functional limitation, physical, psychological, and social disability. According to the College of Prosthodontics, 120 million people in the U.S. are edentulous with 36 million people missing at least one tooth.

Advancements in surgical and restorative dentistry have revolutionized the dental profession's ability to revive even the hopeless dentition with dental implants. With such therapeutic value, dental implants have become the standard of care for the replacement of missing teeth. Not only has implant dentistry expanded the treatment options for delivering dental care to our patients, it has also cultivated new career paths for dental hygienists, dentists, and auxiliary staff alike.
